You must remember to do this otherwise we cannot guarantee your details will be processed. Junior members are aged 18 years and under. Senior members are any age above 18.

British Riding Clubs and British Eventing Leagues and BS Discounted Membership Prices:
British Riding Clubs (BRC) offer exciting opportunities to BRC members competing with BE.
Continuing for 2022 we will be running a league for all levels from BE80 to BE Intermediate. A cost of



£6.50 per combination will be charged for the year to enter this league. This fee will cover all heights and can be paid over the phone or via the entry website - BRC Entry website

These leagues will be published on the BRC website and points will be awarded to all BRC members who <u>complete</u> in all levels from BE80 – BE Intermediate excluding FEI \*, \*\* and \*\*\* competitions or BE Championships.

BRC and BE will be awarding rosettes to 10th place. Prizes will be awarded in kind. To register for the BRC League, members will need to give British Showjumping Membership their BRC Membership number. If you are a BRC member wishing to join British Showjumping for the first time, there is a BRC Membership Offer where both horse and rider can join for a discounted combined rate of £136 for the year.

Training and Clinics: We try to be super organised and get the dates planned and organised months in advance so you know exactly when everything is happening so you can plan too. We use my riding life for the majority of our clinics to book onto. Please see our facebook page or web site. There is a link on our home page that takes you straight to my riding life. There is also a link to tell you a little bit about our regular trainers. When attending the clinics please arrive in good time so you are ready to ride at your allocated time slot. Please do not leave horses tied up unattended at any time and please clear any dropping up. We are very lucky we have some lovely venues that we use and have done for many years and we do not want to lose them because we have not cleared up properly. Venues HHRC use regularly are: Home Farm, Alconbury. New farm, Meadow Lane, Earith and Moats Way Equestrian, Hemmingford. Times for clinics are e mailed to all attendees approximately 2 days before the clinic. This e mail is sent directly from the clinic organiser.

## **Refunds for Clinics:**

If we have to cancel a clinic for any reason a full refund will be given. If you cancel for any other reason and we can replace you we will refund you. Please do bear in mind a replacement might not happen until the last minute.

For all refunds you will receive an e mail from the clinic organiser or treasurer and you will need to reply to the e mail for the refund process to continue.

**Camp:** For the first time in many years HHRC are holding a residential camp in 2022 which has been very well supported by the members. We hope to do this in future years. We hope this continues as a residential camp and will take place in the summer months when it's a bit warmer!!



**Balls and other Socials:** Prior to Covid 19 we enjoyed BBQ's and balls. It is something we hope to do again very soon. Watch this space.........



**Points League and Awards:** We run a yearly points league for juniors and seniors. Events you take part in or help with get rewarded We also run a yearly awards night (sometimes is part of the ball). This is where we recognise members achievements over the year, both on and off horses and award trophies.

**Unaffiliated Dressage Competitions:** We have run these for the last 5 years at Home Farm, Alconbury. These have always been aimed at give it a go – all welcome. We do however need more help to run these events. Let us know if you think you could help.

**Sunday Fun Jump Club:** This is something HHRC ran every other month on a Sunday at New Farm, Meadow Lane, Earith. It is something we would live to run again but require a few more hands to organise it.



#### **Qualifiers:**

Throughout the year clubs of Area 7 organise qualifiers where there is a chance to qualify for the BRC National Championships and not only represent your club but also Area 7. These take place throughout the year. There are the following events: Indoor and Outdoor Dressage and SJ, Horse Trials, Arena Eventing, Arena Challenge, Combined Training, DTM, Qualdrille. Further details regarding these qualifiers and championships can be found on the BRC website under championships. BRC also offer direct entries of classes to championships. All details relating to qualifiers is e mailed out to the club when dates are confirmed and if you're interested in competing you must contact one of our team managers. From then on you will hear from our team managers direct. They will enter you and put everyone in teams etc. You will be required to provide your horses passport details and micro chip number.

Each club for qualifiers has to pay something called a prelim fee to Head Office at least 21 days prior to the qualifier date. Once these are submitted the clubs are contracted to pay entry fees to the organiser regardless if we WD or not. HHRC pay all members prelim fees and the riders taking part are asked to pay for their entry fee only. If you WD after the prelim fees have been paid you are still required to pay your entry fee. If we manage to replace you a refund will be issued in the same way as training (detailed above)





HHRC have always been very successful at qualifiers and championships and have always had a great time making new friends along the way.

As well as qualifiers there are a lot of other competitions that are open to Riding Club members these include: Hickstead team of 3 showjumping, 2 Day Event, Rockingham International team showjumping, Houghton International team dressage, Bolesworth International team showjumping

**Helpers:** At qualifiers and championships we have to provide helpers to run the event. This is usually in the form of pole picking, stewarding etc. If we don't supply helpers, teams are eliminated. It is so important that we all rally round and help each other in supporting help at these events. Remember we can only be as successful as a club with the help the club members provide. We also run events throughout the year, all help no matter how big or small is greatly appreciated.

**Points League:** We are back with points league this year as we are back in full swing. The annual awards night will be back too. Points can be obtained from many different avenues of events that are run. We are also re introducing the volunteers league – for help and support you provide you will gain points and we all know what points mean......Prizes!!! Watch this space for more details
